



Package for InDesign

InDesign has a simple command that packages all the items you used to make your document, and gathers them together in one folder to send to your printer.

Under "File" at the top menu bar, choose "Package..."



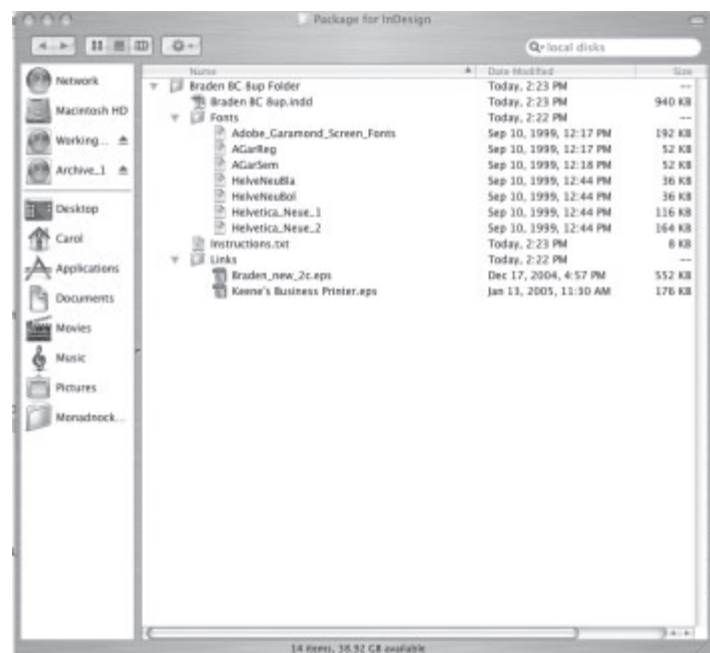
In the first dialog box, you can enter contact information and click "Continue".

At the bottom of the next dialog box, you can select the kinds of items you would like to package—Fonts, Linked Pictures, Update Graphic Links, and Fonts and Links in Hidden Document Layers.

Choose "New Folder" to create a new, clean folder to store all these in. Click "Save". Read the Font Alert information, and click "OK".

Carefully examine the resulting folder to make sure it DOES contain all your items before you copy it to your zip disk or CD.

Send it along with the latest laser proofs of your job for the prepress department to verify the integrity of your job.
